The mission of Cornerstone Healthy Clergy, Congregations and Communities (Cornerstone-BCH3C) is working towards a Healthier Community; to facilitate a process of collaborating the faith community with community agencies; to provide services that will combat negative barriers and conditions that lead to harmful health, fitness and wellness of the citizens living in Beaufort County, Eastern North Carolina; to assist by providing positive information, resources, training, and opportunities that will promote and improve the health and wellness of people for a better quality and increased quantity of life.

Cornerstone's **FUN** Programs is designed to provide parental and sibling interaction with a nationally recognized parenting curriculum; designed to help parents and children recognize destructive nurturing habits patterns, break these habits and replace them with positive, rewarding *nurturing family relationships*.

Cornerstone's Families Understanding Nurturing (FUN) Program provides two series of classes to serve families in Beaufort County. Classes are provided in the spring (March-June) and fall (August-November) months.

The **FUN** Curriculum is developed from a strong philosophical basis that supports the growth and development of parents and children as caring people who treat themselves, others, and the environment with respect and dignity.

Cornerstone's **The Parent Support Group** (**PSG**) is an addition to the **FUN program**. Parents and children can be a part of this group only after going through the 16 sessions of the **FUN program**. It is guided by the parents but there is a Facilitator to keep the class on course.

(PSG) provides parent to parent support, education, and opportunities to discuss parenting challenges, strategies, and to help inspire each other to build bright futures in their homes and community.

(PSG) supports the child both at home and in their education. Studies have shown that children whose parents are involved in their education have higher grades and test scores and are more likely to complete their education.

### Nurturing Family Relationships
