The Cornerstone Community Based Programs has initiated a new program called "Silver Belles" to assist the elderly citizens living in the Beaufort County area. This program will be centered around the elderly that do not have members of their family or close friends in the city to check on them on a regular basis. Cornerstone Community Based Programs will develop an online contact form which will consist of the elderly person's name, address, and telephone number, along with other important information.

The Silver Belles Program will offer one-on-one and group community outreach dedicated to the elderly sixty and older. This age group will be offered care, comfort, food, exercise, and encouragement by visitation, sending notes/ cards, bi-weekly telephone calls and other engaging activities and resources to those that are willing to participate. Any elderly with a special need or an emergency need due to an unusual circumstance or natural disaster will be referred to an agency in the city that can help with what is needed.

Cornerstone Community Based Programs will partner with other agencies and churches to better serve the elderly in Beaufort County. Cornerstone Community Based Programs will provide the Silver Belles an emergency contact form to list emergency names and telephone numbers in case of an emergency.
